

Before you apply:

All students attending AISD must present evidence that the following routine childhood immunizations and applicable boosters (as defined by the CDC: Center for Disease Control and Prevention) have been administered prior to admission.

As evidence, all immunization dates must be entered into the AISD online admission form. Copies of the official immunization record(s), stamped or signed by a physician or qualified licensed health care provider, must also be uploaded through the form.

AISD REQUIRED VACCINES:

Birth through 6 years:

- DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
 - 4th dose must be given after 4th birthday
- Poliomyelitis
 - 4th dose must be given after 4th birthday
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
 - 2 doses if above 4 years old
- Varicella
 - 2 doses if above 4 years old
- Hepatitis B
 - 3 doses
- Hepatitis A
 - 2 doses
- Haemophilis influenzae B (Hib)
 - 4 doses if less than 5 years of age
- Pneumococcus
 - 4 doses if less than 5 years of age

11---12 years:

- Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis)
 - Single dose

AISD RECOMMENDED VACCINES:

- Rabies
- Typhoid
- Seasonal Influenza
- MCV4 (Meningococcal Polysaccharide Conjugate)
- HPV (Human Papillomavirus)

AISD TUBERCULOSIS SCREENING REQUIREMENT:

Students must be screened for tuberculosis upon entry and then every two years thereafter. Acceptable screening tests are a Tuberculin skin test or a Quantiferon blood test.

Students under five years old are encouraged to receive the BCG vaccine. Students who received the BCG vaccination before age five do not require screening for the first ten years following vaccination.
